No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Payment must accompany entry:

No hand deliveries will be accepted in the first twenty-four hours following the opening date and time. Telephone, email and fax entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms or Entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the form are not acceptable. Unsigned Entry Forms cannot be accepted nor entries which specify any conditions as to its acceptance. Entry Forms MUST be filled out completely. Incomplete entries do not constitute a valid entry.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please print or type clearly and do not use tape or staples!

Illegible entries:

Will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$35 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Entry form changes, additions, corrections and cancellations MUST BE RECEIVED IN WRITING PRIOR TO THE **OCTOBER 18, 2024 CLOSING DATE at Noon**, be legible and include the AKC number, or no refund will be issued. No telephone changes accepted.

Measuring and Height Card Information:

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process:

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the **Dogs To Be Measured List**. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during the day of show check-in.

ISC INFORMATION

Purpose: The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various international style Standard and Jumpers With Weaves courses. The rules for This class are generally based on international rules. The variety in international agility Course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge Of The Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in excellent / master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC website (http://www.akc.org).

Eligibility: This class is open to dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials. Jump heights: Dogs may be entered in their regular jump heights, however, only those dogs running in the 12" & 16" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC Cutoffs) or any dog entering the 24" jump height will be eligible for the direct invitation to World Team Tryouts. The FCI/ISC cutoffs for those heights are as follows:

- 12" Small team shoulder height = 13 3/4" or less (35 cm is the FCI cutoff)
- 16" Medium team shoulder height = 16 7/8" or less (43 cm is the FCI cutoff)
- 20" Intermediate team shoulder height = 18 7/8" or less (48 cm is the FCI cutoff)
- 24" Large team shoulder height = greater than 18 7/8" (greater than 48 cm)

Qualifications: Clean run scores from ISC classes may be used toward fulfilling the minimum requirements for *WTT/EOTT. A "clean run" consists of a run without time or course faults. These legs must be earned at your FCI height. Minimum YPS requirements are waived for these scores, as long as the dog is under the course time set by the judge for that class.

*As of January 2023, ISC A1 and J1 clean runs do NOT count toward WTT entry requirements – only ISC A2/J2 and J3/A3. All grades may be used for EOTT.

RIBBONS, AWARDS AND PRIZES FOR REGULAR CLASSES

Rosettes will be awarded to the first through third place dog for each height division of each class. Ribbon flats will be awarded for Qualifying scores.

Additional prizes for first place winners. All awards must be claimed at the show.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER TRIALS

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registrable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The Mudi Club of America, Sue Marshall Arena, the trial secretary, their agents and assigns, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians.

IF IT IS NECESSARY TO RESCUE A DOG from a parked car on the show grounds, the Club will not be responsible or liable for any damage to the car involved.

Owners or handlers entering dogs in a trial do so at their own risk and agree to assume responsibility for any damage caused by them, or by their dogs. They also agree to abide by the Rules of the American Kennel Club and the current edition of the AKC Agility Regulations.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering thistrial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all the obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

MIXED HEIGHTS AND CLASSES

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day:

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

FEO & FIX AND GO ON

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO):

For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the ISC, Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the
 dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run
 and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.

Fix and Go On:

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM-UPS

The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered only in that class.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. **No refunds for overpayments of \$10 or less.**

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund entry fees minus \$5 processing fee per day for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials.

100% of entry fees will be refunded if a written request is received by the trial secretary on or before the trial closing date. After closing, refunds will be given only if notification is received not less than 48 hours prior to the start of the trial in the case of injured or ill handlers or dogs minus \$5 processing fee per day of entry. Verification from a doctor or veterinarian may be required at the club's discretion.

MOVE UPS

Written requests for dogs to be moved-up to a higher class, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, will be accepted at the trial secretary's address or via email until Monday, October 28, 2024 at 6:00 pm.

AFTER CLOSING WAIT LIST

A waiting list will be maintained for these trials once they have closed on October 18, 2024. The waiting list will be active until its deadline - Saturday, October 26, 2024 at 6:00 pm.

Any runs that are entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by runs in order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed for the number of runs replaced. If a run is pulled, but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent from the run. Entry fees for runs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date, will be refunded in full.

SITE INFORMATION

The show site is indoors on artificial turf with infill. Please bring your own crate, clean up supplies and water for your dog. Crating out of your car is very convenient, please plan to do so. Indoor crating is available in the barn across the front of the arena.

There is a \$10 fine for any potty accidents on the turf! No spiked shoes or heels allowed on the turf. Please wear clean athletic footwear to preserve the flooring.

The grounds will be open no earlier than 7:00 am on the first day of the event.

All dogs must be kept on leash at all times, except when using the practice jump or while in the ring. A warm-up area with warm-up jump is available outdoors next to the building.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without the benefit of a refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

Please be respectful and do not let your dog eliminate on or near building structures, equipment or anything a person may have to touch. Any accidents inside the building must be cleaned up immediately.

WORKERS & VOLUNTEERS

We need your help at this event! Keeping the event running smoothly requires volunteers – the show cannot go on without you! We welcome and greatly appreciate your help.

Care will be taken to allow you plenty of time for your own dogs and we are happy to explain to you what your job involves.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE

From Highway 20 turn north from the roundabout onto Hamby Rd. follow about a mile to Neff. At Neff RD. Turn right. In about a 1/4 mile turn left into the driveway of 21700 Neff Rd. Take the right driveway with the wrought iron horse fence. Follow the driveway to the house, and take the first left onto the gravel drive. You may park in designated areas around the arena.

DRIVE NO MORE THAN 10 MPH ON DRIVEWAY.

The Sue Marshall Arena is found easily with GPS directions.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramsM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
